Future is what will be written about us on the "Tablets of Love and Memory."

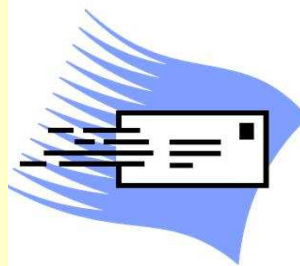

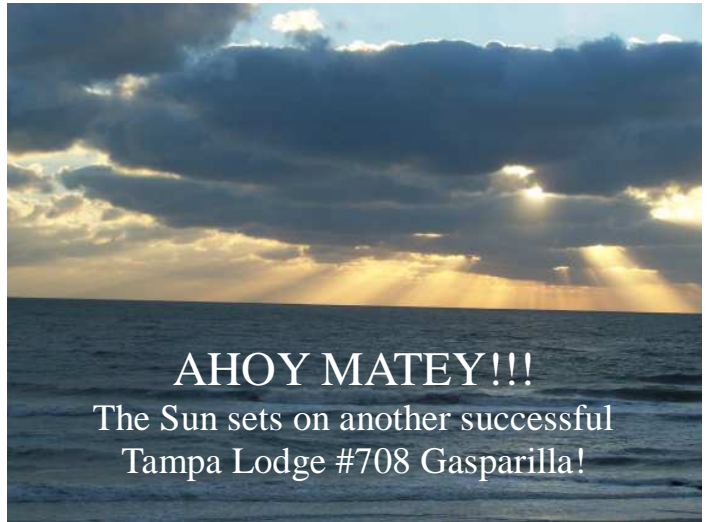


