YOUR LODGE NEEDS A

From the time your Lodge relocated to Gandy Blvd. in 1982 until 1994, repairs, maintenance and replacements were ordinary. In 1995 the Lodge expended \$29,000 to replace the entire roof and the front and back air handling systems. Since then all three areas have required repairs and patching with installation of new air handlers in both areas. Now The Roof! When it rained last week three ceiling tiles were removed and buckets placed in the kitchen, office and Lodge Room. Electrical and otherwise, we are cautious of potential safety and damage issues.

The Board of Directors have been researching and investigating possible roof solutions since last August. Their findings and final proposal was presented to Tampa P.I.P. donor members and then to the Lodge for floor approval on 1-22-14. The Lodge approved the lowest responsible expenditure of \$35,816.00 with 60% being withdrawn from the Ameriprise investment account (which substantially depletes its balance) and the remainder by a loan from the Lodge Ameriprise P.I.P. account. The Lodge also voted to deposit future receipts toward the roof 100% to P.I.P., if so designated as P.I.P. All other contributions will be deposited 60% to the Lodge investment account and 40% to the P.I.P. account. Your check should be made out according to your wishes.

Within the WCD, the St. Petersburg Lodge has twice raised funds from members donations to cover major building, equipment and pool repairs and replacements. Your Board is confident that the caring and sharing interests of Tampa members towards sustaining our Lodge and the excellent work we do with disadvantaged children, veterans and others in need is equally as strong.



Grand Lodge Convention Information:

The Elk's Grand Lodge Convention will be held at the New Orleans Ernst N Morial Convention Center 900 Convention Center Blvd New Orleans, LA 70130 from July 13th to July 17, 2014.

While any Elk may attend the convention and enjoy many activities, only the Current and Past Exalted Rulers may attend the Business Sessions of the convention, which are held Monday thru Thursday from 8am until noon.

Details: Everyone must be registered; your Badge must be displayed for admission into the EXHIBIT, SESSION halls and all Elks-related functions associated with this convention. The first obligation of all representatives is to register and obtain badges. All Grand Lodge Members, Exalted Rulers, visiting Elks and their guests can register. Information pamphlets are provided at the registration area to tell you about the convention and events going on during the convention. The New Orleans Ernst N. Morial Convention Center should be considered your information center. **The Registration Fee is \$50.00 for Elk members only**. There is no fee for Non-Elk spouses registering with an Elk member.

There are various classes offered for all Elks throughout the week, beginning on Saturday the 12th at 9 AM. Registration also opens on the 12th. Opening Ceremonies are held on Sunday July 13th from 3-5PM. The convention closes on the 17th at 11AM.

Each State has ONE person in charge of housing. In Florida it is the State Secretary, Carl Seibert. He may be reached at carl@mpinet.net or 800-523-1673 ext. 230. Florida has been assigned to the JW Marriott Hotel which is on Canal between Royal and Charles. Six other states are also assigned that hotel. To receive the special convention rates you must go through Carl.

Admission Process

The first step in being considered for admission to the therapy services program is to contact the Tampa Elks Lodge Secretary or call the Program Administrator at 1-800-523-1673 ext. 240 and request an application.

As soon as the application is received, it will be reviewed to determine if the therapy program is appropriate for the patient's needs. If the patient is accepted into the program, a regular weekly home visitation schedule is established. Parents are required to be present so they can carry out treatments between visits by the therapist.




We had a great turnout and delicious offerings for our March "Green Food" gathering. Not only did we wine


