





Lodge Roof Proposal

On January 8th a recommendation from the Board of Directors on replacement of the Lodge roof, and the funding for same will be read to the membership. Your Board has voted to recommend OPTION #1 below. At the January 22nd Lodge meeting the matter will be voted upon. Below is a comparison of the two plans for financing which were considered as options. As a side note, no fewer than three different firms were contacted for a look at our roof and consideration of a repair/replace alternative. All came to the same conclusion....the roof is not repairable beyond one year....with no guarantees!

OPTION #1

Recommended by The Board of Directors of Tampa Lodge #708

- 1. Use existing funds from two Investment Assets to complete a Roof-Over method of restoration. The Westfall Roofing Company offers a 20 year materials and labor warrantee for just under \$37,000.00 that includes a 1st 5 year enhancement of Early Roofing Life.
- 2. Lodge P.I.P. (Partners In Progress) fund investors agree with the Board of Directors that the recommended NO RISK/NO DEBT option is best.
- 3. This option would not use/affect Annual Dues Funds.
- 4. Option #1 would favorably encourage the Lodge's membership to donate to rebuild the Lodge's Investment Funds while remaining debt free.

OPTION #2

NOT Recommended by the Board of Directors of Tampa Lodge #708

- 1. Pay one-half of roof cost from existing Lodge Funds and Secure a Commercial Building Property Mortgage Bank loan with a five year pay-off term at approximately 6.5% per year interest. This option would obligate the Lodge to pay about \$392.00 per month plus taxes and insurance for the 60 month term. (Early payoff of a Commercial Property Loan is NOT an option...full payment of loan and all interest is REQUIRED.
- 2. The 2 Lodge investment accounts are in mutual funds paying about 1% annually.
- 3. Utilization of a Commercial Property Loan would obligate the Lodge to increase fundraising levels substantially during the 5 years of loan life.


