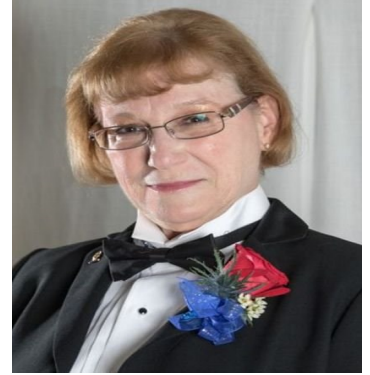

Club Chivalry News

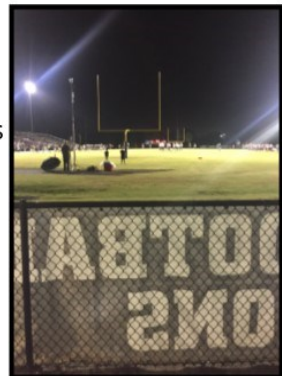
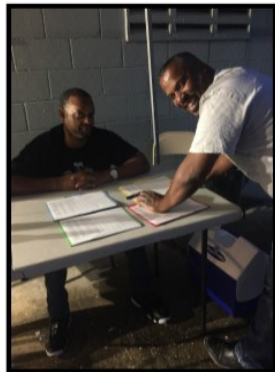
