Whereas, he has been a member of the Order for fifty-three years, having been initiated in to Robinson, Illinois Lodge No. 1188 on October 17, 1968 and transferred to Tampa Lodge No. 708 on September 19, 1979 following a promotion relocation as an Executive of Walter Industries, Inc. He was given the honor of being named Elk of the Year in 1992 – 1993 and Officer of the Year in 1993 – 1994 and served as Exalted Ruler in 1995 – 1996, Trustee from 1996 – 1999 and Chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1999, was Lodge Advisor for fifteen years, and he became a Life Member on October 22, 2003. He served as Chairman of the Lodge Audit Committee for fourteen years, Government Relations Committee for six years, the Lodge's Centennial Anniversary Committee in 2002, and, for the past twenty-one years, as Chairman of the Lodge's major Annual Gasparilla Fundraising Event. He has earned numerous awards in District and State Ritual Competitions and, in 1995 – 1996, ten different awards from other national and state contests. In 2008 – 2009, he was the second largest recruiter of Membership in the country, and

Whereas, he has chaired several committees in his lodge and the West Central District and has been West Central District Leader since October 2002 and was Southwest District Leader simultaneously from 2007- 2011, and

Whereas, he has served the Florida State Elks Association as a member of the Business Practices Committee for thirty years and its leader since 1995, has been a Trustee and a Director of the State's Investment Trust Fund since February 2000, served on the State Elks Training Staff for eight years, and served as West Central District Vice-President 1998 – 1999, State Vice President at Large in 2003 – 2004, and as President of the FSEA in 2004 – 2005. He is presently Chairman of the State's Major Projects Committee that encompasses Children's Therapy Services and the Florida Elks Youth Camp. He was inducted into the State Elks Softball Hall of Fame in 2006 and has played in over twenty Annual State Tournaments, and

Whereas, he served the Grand Lodge as District Deputy for the West Central District in 1999 – 2000, served on the Grand Lodge Audit and Accounting Committee from 2005 – 2007, and is currently serving as a Grand Lodge Special Representative within the West Central District, and

Whereas, he graduated with honors from Bradley University in Peoria, IL, and he served his country for six years in the U.S. Army, receiving an Honorable Discharge in 1966 with the rank of Sargent, having served with the 301st Signal Corps during the Berlin Crisis, and,

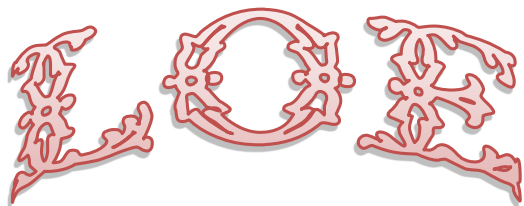

It's time to Start Spreading the News!

Even if schools are closed, our Elk's National Foundation (ENF) Scholarships for our Most Valuable Students (MVS) will be open on August 5th! And I must say, I am excited about this program! For current seniors, that means the academics are in, and due to the shutdowns caused by Covid-19, there is no need for an ACT or SAT test score this year!

(I just LOVE THAT CHANGE – ask me why!)

The deadline for submitting the applications is November 15th.

This is how it works:

Starting on August 5th, there will be a big button near the top of the [ENF.Elks.org /MVS](http://ENF.Elks.org/MVS) page. Students fill out the application completely online. The application will also require input from their high school guidance counselor. In addition to grades and the degree of difficulty of their classes they will also be judged based on demonstrated leadership and financial need.

Boys and Girls compete separately! When ENF gives out over 2 million dollars to 500 seniors in new scholarships this year, half will be to boys and half will be to girls. ALL MVS scholarships are awarded as four year scholarships to full time students pursuing a four year degree at an accredited college or university, with the total per student ranging from \$4000 to \$50,000.

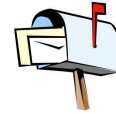
