Nine days – at times it felt like 90, but looking back, it was gone in a flash.

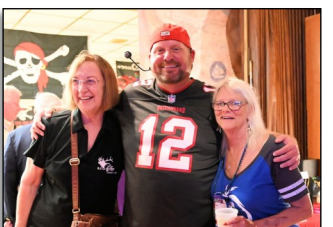
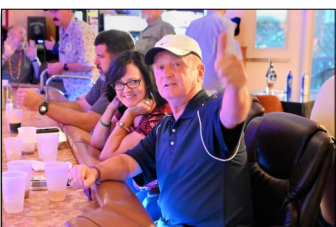
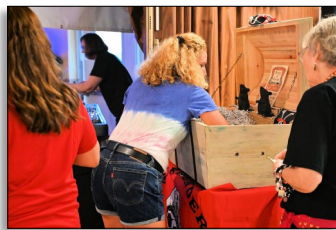
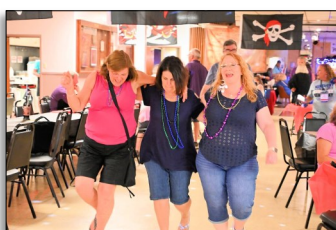
