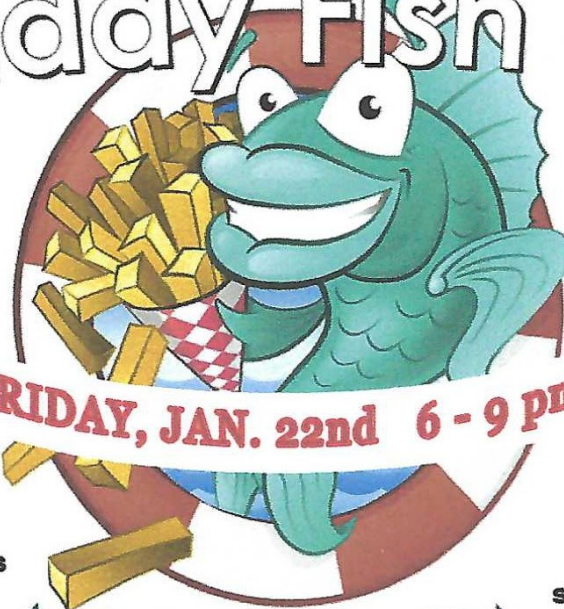

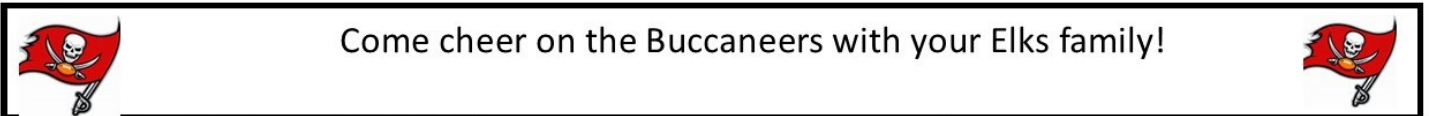



Due to the ongoing pandemic, we have decided to cancel the Partners in Progress banquet originally scheduled for February 6, 2021. We will reschedule it at a future time when things return to normal. 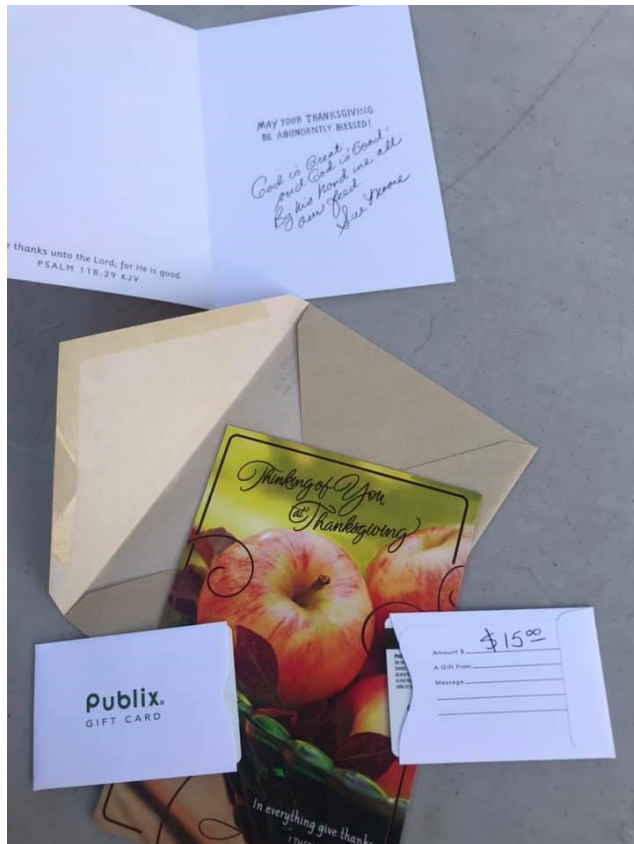
