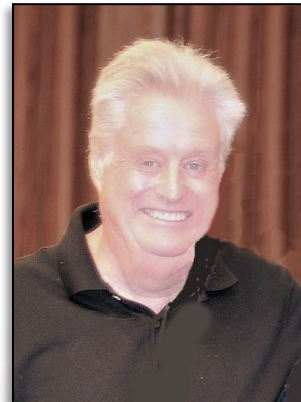

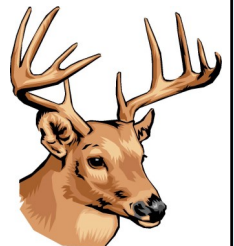

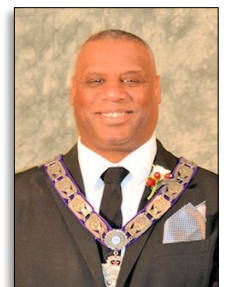
ELK OF THE MONTH...JASON BROWN & CRYSTAL JOHNSON

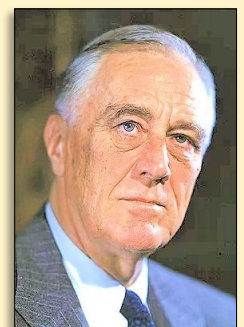
