
ELK OF THE MONTH...JAN BERTOCH

708 - FUN BOAT, FUN DAY FOR OUR VETS



On February 24th, 2024, the Tampa Elks Veteran's Committee hosted 28 Veterans for a trip on the Hillsborough River. At 10:00am, twenty-eight Veterans and four Elks met up in the parking lot at Rick's on the River. The veterans were from Liberty Manor for Veterans, The Salvation Army, and New Beginnings of Tampa. This was the final event for the Freedom Grant. Tampa Elks had received special permission from the manager at Rick's to Board the Tampa Fun Boat from their riverside dock instead of downtown. That eliminates parking issues. The Fun Boat is owned by seven-year member Shannon Wheatley, who was able to give us a great deal. The boat arrived at 10:00 sharp, and we were soon on board and on our way down river. We passed Blake HS and Jullian Lane Riverfront Park, but by the time we got to the University of Tampa and passed the Straz Center for the performing arts, we found out it was an extra exciting day on the riverfront. The Gasparilla 5K or 10K Run had just been completed. There were a lot of runners and spectators that waved to us as we went under the bridges and along the riverwalk. After clearing downtown and Harbor Island, we veered east and did a complete circle of Davis Island, all the while learning some great historical facts from the crew. The top attractions were the dolphins that ran around and under the boat as we hit the delta, but a close second was the huge mansion that Derek Jeter had built for his family then leased to Tom Brady! It is hard to imagine that it is now being torn down and replaced, but from our vantage point we could see there was not any privacy at all. After circling the island, we headed back upriver and docked at Rick's at about 11:45 – just in time for lunch.

We had let everybody choose their meal while they were still on the boat, using a special menu with plenty of variety but a price point that fit our budget. That system made things very easy for the waitress at Ricks on the River, and we were soon eating in small groups of 4-6 per table. After lunch, as the Veterans were leaving, we held Salvation Army back and presented them with a \$500 check from the Gratitude Grant.






