

Have you heard of the Harry Anna Trust Fund? That is the charitable fund that supports the Florida Elks Youth Camp and the Florida Elks Children's Therapy Services. The trust fund was started in 1951 and is named after Harry and Anna Miller, who donated the original land and building that became the Florida Elk's Hospital for Crippled Children. This fund collects the donations and endowments for the state major projects. The Harry Anna Trust Fund is restricted, so that only the income it generates can be used to support the projects. The land the Millers donated became the Florida Elk's Youth Camp, and the hospital services segued into the Florida Elk's Therapy Services which provides in home occupational and physical therapy. No government funds or insurance funds are used for either project. Your donations make both possible!

This month I received a full house of change from Bonnie Atwood and Jacqui LoCicero, and the equivalent of about 4 houses from Donna Halsey. The donations from the dining room and lounge are on the upswing, too. Thank you for each and every penny- it makes a difference in the life of a child!
