



The 2022 Most Valuable Student Scholarship application is open. Deadline is November 15th.

Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need.

Eligibility:

• Current high school seniors, or the equivalent, who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply.

- Applicants do not need to be related to a member of the Elks.
- High school graduates are not eligible to apply.

Applicants must be citizens of the United States on the date their applications are submitted; permanent legal resident status does not qualify.

Helpful Hints from Rita:

Leave no section empty- see what can be moved from another section instead. For example: National Honor Society is a extracurricular, but Honor Roll is an award.

Do not delay your application due to the school college counselor not having replied. Submit your application on time. The counselor's input can be added if it arrives within a few days.

Be sure the college counselor knows to compare the difficulty of your studies with the average HS student, not just those in your advanced program, like Dual or IB.
