
I will soon appoint an Inner Guard whose steady hand & sharp mind will allow us to conduct our two monthly meetings with proper decorum.



The Florida Elks Therapy Services (FECTS) provides in home physical and occupational therapy to Florida children in need of such services. This rehabilitation is necessary to be rendered in the home because of the absence of these services locally, or because the patient is not easily transported to services or is infirmed at home. Priority is given to children who do not have ready access to therapy as a result of financial considerations. The therapists who provide these services are employed by the Florida Elks and are either OT or PT's licensed to practice by the State of Florida. Applications for services can be obtained from the Lodge or by calling 1-800-523-1673.

Isn't it amazing that the little bit of change in your pocket each visit to the Lodge can do so much good? Feel free to take a house home and put it on your nightstand or near your washing machine to collect the loose change around your house.

From June 15th to July 15th I received generous donations from the dining and Lounge areas, and the equivalent of 8 houses full from Debbie Osterbrock.
