

With this grant, we would purchase and install a 150" viewing screen, and provide a Wii console, a home theatre quality projector and sound system at the newly contracted Cares-Busansky Senior center, which provides adult day care to our neighborhood.

In addition, we would give demonstrations of some of various senior activities it enables, provide refreshments, and take on duties of host/hostesses to approximately 150 seniors, caregivers and community, county and VA administration leaders during their grand re-opening ceremonies on June 26, 2014.






