

A SUNNY AFTERNOON ON THE WATER FOR OUR VETS!

November 2nd hosted 24 transitional veterans on an hour and a half river cruse through downtown Tampa, followed by a riverside lunch.

The Tampa Fun Boat holds 35 people, and we booked the whole boat. Because the owner's wife is an Elk, we get a terrific price. We invited a total of 25 Veterans from the Salvation Army Red Center, New Beginnings of Tampa, and Liberty Manor for Veterans. We also invited 10 Elks active on the Veteran or Children's committees to come along; their job was to sit with Vets at lunch and socialize with them. Rick's on the River, a popular riverfront restaurant, was kind enough to let us leave from their docks. That prevented us having to pay downtown parking prices. Everybody was at the dock by 10:00 – but then one Veteran declined to get on the boat so he and his driver had to leave. As the Grant writer, my job was to be on standby and manage the payments, so when that opening arose, I hopped on the boat.

The Tampa Riverfront is still a work in progress, with the downtown side highly developed for several miles north of the city's center and the west side- not so much. The city center is usually defined as Kennedy Blvd., where the University of Tampa's famous spires overlook the river. The city has recently announced that will change, so it was interesting to see what they have to work with. We also saw some signs of the recent hurricanes, such as a large sailboat that was in somebody's yard on Harbor Island. Towards the end of our trip, we handed out limited menus from which everyone was to choose their meal and then just hand to their server. With that method, we eliminate the confusion of single payer at different tables and also keep closer to our budget.

By the time we returned to the dock at Rick's everybody was ready for some food. The Fish was the most popular menu item, whether fried filet or blackened sandwiches. This was a great way to give the Veterans a break from their normal weekend of doing mostly nothing as the program services are mostly weekdays. You could see them coming out of their shell during the day, and by the end of lunch we were pretty much friends.

VETERANS COMMITTEE REPORT

As you may know, our Tampa Elks 708 Lodge Veterans Committee serves both honorably discharged US military veteran members of Tampa Elks 708 as well as non-member veterans that are in transitional housing in local shelters.

The Lodge Veterans Committee meets every month on the second Monday at 6:30pm, is self-funded, and operates on Elks National Foundation grants, charitable donations, and committee fundraisers. This year's fundraiser was the sale of smoked turkey breasts and Boston Butts that were prepared in the lodge parking lot and picked up on Wednesday, November 27th....just in time to enjoy at our Thanksgiving gatherings. A huge THANK YOU to those who supported this fundraiser!

Probably our most visible effort, your committee hosts veterans from four different Tampa Bay area shelters for dinners at the lodge. Since February, we've hosted (and paid for) over 100 dinners for these unhoused veterans and shelter staff.

For our annual Flag Day service on Friday, June 14th, we not only hosted veterans from Liberty Manor for dinner, but we also incorporated the veterans into our ceremony. They proudly paraded numerous versions of Old Glory as our Exalted Ruler read this informative and inspirational ritual.



Your Lodge Veterans Committee hosted veterans from the Salvation Army's Red Shield Center at the Florida Elks *Day at the Rays* event at Tropicana Field on August 18, 2024.

As November is National Veteran and Military Family month, we felt that there was no better way to show our gratitude to those who served (or are still serving) than to host a meal for our lodge veterans and their guests. We had over eighteen Tampa Elks 708 military veterans in attendance on Friday, November 8th for a meal planned and prepared (with Chef Courtney's help, of course) by your LVC. The chicken wings, barbequed ribs, twice baked potatoes, smoky coleslaw, Cowboy beans, and banana pudding cake were enjoyed by all!
