



Tampa 708 is Proud to Support the Southeastern Guide D\$gs Program


On January 30th at 2:15 exalted Ruler Wendy Hall, her sister and Leading Knight Tracy Horrell, PER and Rita Smith, PER made the trip to Palmetto Beach, home of the beautiful campus of Southeastern Guide Dogs. Tampa Elks have been involved with this charity since at least 2012, when Tracy Horrell, then the Exalted Ruler, and Paul DeLand PER, wrote a \$2000 Gratitude Grant for their "Paws for Patriots" program. Guide dogs are now trained on campus and then provided to the blind, the disabled, and to law enforcement. In the dozen or so years that Tampa Elks have been involved, the campus has grown from a one building office with outdoor kennels to a state-ofthe-art facility, with separate buildings for breeding, administration, guest quarters for the disabled who come to train with their guide dog, puppies under 3 months, guide dogs in training and even a canine infirmary with full time staff. Tampa Elks have been recognized in more than one location as the facility has grown. Tracy Horrell, PER who is currently Tampa's Leading Knight, has volunteered as a puppy trainer for several different dogs, taking them into her home at 3 months and "socializing" them until they are a year old and ready for more specific training.







The check was delivered, and we drove across campus in the hopes of getting into the puppy kennels for a peek. Unfortunately, they were locked up for the day, but we did run into a volunteer that is on Tracy's Macdill fundraising team – Nick Dinisio and his breeding dog Siren, who was still nursing puppies. The name Siren was chosen for this dog because of it's two main meanings – The mystical siren – a strong female who commands power over men of the sea, and the more common siren which is an alarm, signal, or warning - in essence a guide to avoid danger.
